Unless otherwise stated, all pricing relates to the provision of services within 100 km by road of our funeral home(s), initiated and completed between 9:00am and 5:00pm Monday to Friday (excluding public holidays). Our Professional Service Fee is based on a standard adult funeral during normal business hours; other options are available on request.

Professional Service Fee

Single Service — Burial or Cremation

\$4,800

Arrangement and conduct of the funeral, transportation of the deceased to the service, and all clerical, administrative and legal requirements.

Dual Service — Burial or Cremation

\$5,100

As above, where the service and committal are held at two separate locations.
