Performing Arts Showcase Concert 2022

We invite our students who have private music/drama/dance lessons to showcase their talents and skills at our annual Performing Arts Showcase Concert.

Performance Dates

K-6 students will be performing on Tuesday, 6 December. Sessions will run throughout the day.

Students are able to perform a *maximum of two times* during the concert. This may be performing with others, playing a different instrument or doing a different performance (i.e., one music item and one drama item).

Rehearsal sessions will occur on Monday, 5 December. The purpose of these is to give our student comperes a chance to run through the concert sessions and to problem solve any issues that arise. Performing students need only to 'walk' through their rehearsal session and will not need their costumes or instruments.



COVID Protocols

Parents are invited this year to be part of our audience. Please use hand sanitiser and follow any other COVID-related requests when you arrive.

Who is eligible to perform?

Performers must be students who are currently having private lessons or tuition in Music, Drama or Dance.

Entry Forms

An entry form is included with this note. Please return completed forms to the school office by Friday November 18. Due to the organisational demands of this event, **no late entries** will be accepted. If students are performing with other students, please only return *one form per group*.

Please indicate on the form the length of each item and make this as accurate as possible as we are planning within time constraints. Students should aim for *two-minute items or less*, with extra time given for larger group performances. Group items should be *no longer than four minutes*.

Please indicate if there are siblings also performing on the day. Efforts to group performing siblings in the same session will be attempted but not guaranteed.

Entry forms must have their music, dance or drama tutor's signature. A parent's signature is only acceptable if they are the student's actual music or drama teacher. By signing this form your child's music/drama/dance teacher is confirming that your child is ready to perform their song/act to our school audience.

Appropriate Content

When selecting pieces, please ensure the lyrics or content of performance pieces are age appropriate for K-6 students (have a 'G-rating') and fit within our school values.

Backing Music and other audio requirements

Copies of backing tracks are to be given to the school office no later than Friday 25 November.

Also, if special amplification requirements are required your child's performance, please include those on the entry form.

We know that our students will enjoy the opportunity to highlight the work they have been doing throughout the year.
