



# Privacy Policy

## Our Promise

WCC Language Program (WCC LP) respects the privacy, cultural authority, and data rights of all individuals and communities who take part in our research.

We protect Indigenous Cultural and Intellectual Property (ICIP) and follow the principles of Ownership, Control, Access, and Possession (OCAP) and Free, Prior and Informed Consent (FPIC)

## What We Collect

We collect only the information needed to understand Wiradjuri language activity and its speakers, such as contact details, teaching data, and community feedback, through voluntary surveys and interviews.

## Information Is Used To

- Map where and how Wiradjuri language is being taught
- Identify community needs for language resources and support
- Report outcomes back to participating communities and funding bodies
- Data is never sold, shared, or used for any commercial purpose

## Who Can Access It

All collected information remains under the authority of the WCC LP and the Wiradjuri community. Access is limited to authorised WCC LP staff, project partners, and community representatives approved by the relevant language group.

## Storage and Security

Data is stored on secure, encrypted WCC servers and can be viewed, updated, or removed at the request of the data owner or community.

## Consent and Withdrawal

Participation is voluntary. By completing a survey or interview, you consent to WCC LP using your information for the purposes above.
